

What you'll need

Two pieces of black cardPaper clips ● Scissors ● Pencil sharpener ● Wax crayons Two sheets of wax paper ● An iron ● A tea towel ● PVA glue

Start with this amazing 'stained-glass' window... here!

> First, place the two pieces other and secure the edges with paper clips. Then draw your pattern onto the top piece of card.



Make sure Mother's Day is super colourful

Carefully cut out the shapes of the pattern, making sure you cut through both pieces of card.



Use the pencil sharpener to create shavings from different-coloured wax crayons then sprinkle them onto one sheet of the wax paper.







Once the wax has cooled, glue the black card to either side of the wax paper, making sure that the pattern lines up on both sides. Then cut around the outside of the shape.
