Make it

Fluffy lamb pen holder!



What you'll need

- PVA glue
- Cotton bud container
- Scissors
- Cotton balls
- Black felt or foam
- Two wiggly eyes



It's springtime! So why not get in the mood by creating this cute lamb pen holder?

Start here!



1 First, empty the cotton bud container. Then, cover the outside of the container with PVA glue. Use a paintbrush if you need to.



2 Next, carefully stick the cotton balls to the container. Start at the bottom and glue a row to the top, then repeat until you've covered the whole tub.



3 Next, take the black felt or foam and cut out two ears (like a capital letter D without the middle cut out). Then make two hooves and a nose.



4 Almost there! Glue on the wiggly eyes and wait for them to dry.



5 Finally, glue on the ears, nose and hooves, and your pen holder is ready to use! Why not give it as an Easter gift? Cool!
