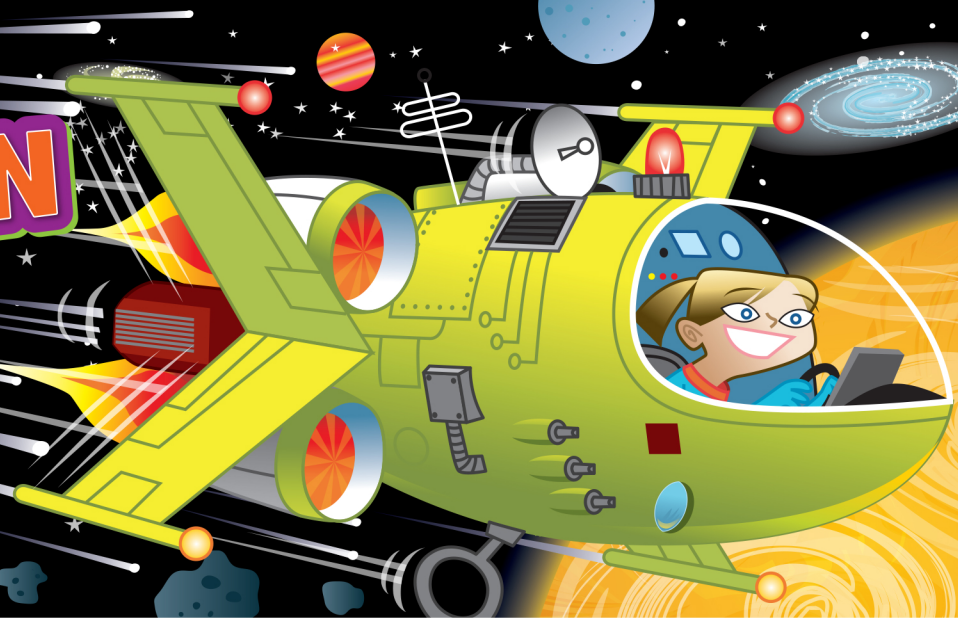


Funny FILL-IN
