- Fork Blender Glasses






the watermelon into quarters, then scrape out the seeds. Chop it

Papier-mâché mix (½ PVA glue, ½ water) Scissors

● Glue ● Newspaper ● Paint Paintbrushes Tissue paper Sweets Ribbon



Blow up the balloon and tie the end with a knot. Rip the newspaper into small strips and paste one or two layers onto the balloon using the papier-mâché mix.



Once the newspaper strips have dried, paint the top half of the balloon. Then, cut the tissue paper into strips and decorate the bottom half by glueing them on.



Carefully pop and remove the balloon, and fill the piñata with sweets. Finally, thread a ribbon through the top of the piñata for the handle and it's ready!
