

# ARCTIC EXPEDITION MAP

## MISSION 2 SET UP CAMP

**EXTRA CHALLENGE**

Get your family to line up all their winter clothes and race to be the first to put them all on!

Brrr! It's so cold here. You need to keep your fingers covered up or else they could freeze!

Build a LEGO base camp while wearing mittens or a pair of socks over your hands!

**START HERE!**

Your arrival is by air because you can't build roads or train tracks on sea ice! And there are no shops here, so you have to bring everything you need with you!

## MISSION 1 MAKE A SLED

It's tough trudging through the snow and ice. Make a sled out of LEGO bricks to help transport your equipment to base camp!

LEGO CITY ARCTIC BASE CAMP

NORTH POLE →

A glacier is a huge mass of ice made from squashed snow. Glaciers are constantly moving – very, very slowly!

## MISSION 3 ROPE RESCUE

Time to trek across the glacier! But first, tie your team together. That way, if one person tumbles down a crack, everyone else will stop the fall!

One of your teammates has fallen down a crack. Which of the ropes will lead them back to the top?

## MISSION 4 BUILD A BRIDGE

Yikes! This crack in the glacier is way too wide to cross. Construct a bridge out of LEGO bricks so you can pass over it!

**FINISH**

Crampons are spikes attached to boots. They help explorers grip when walking on ice or climbing.

## MISSION 6 MOUNTAIN MAZE

You want to scale this massive mountain that no one has ever climbed before! Make your way through the maze to the top!

## MISSION 5 EMERGENCY SHELTER

Uh-oh! You're in the middle of a blizzard. It's almost impossible to see!

With a pile of LEGO bricks in front of you, cover your eyes with a scarf. Then, while blindfolded, build a simple emergency shelter!

## MISSION 7 PASS THE POLAR BEAR

Yikes! The snow has cleared to reveal a polar bear in the distance. What do you do?

Head over to give it a stroke and say hello.

Keep an eye on it and try to move downwind so it can't smell you.

Up close, it looks pretty big and scary. Now what?

Get in the water and swim away.

Try to stay calm and back away slowly.

The bear is getting even closer. What do you do next?

Yell and charge at it!

Make a loud noise with an air horn!

You'll never win if you take on a polar bear – they're 3m tall when standing on their hind legs! Try again!

Yay! You stayed calm and scared the polar bear away with a loud noise. Now call your team for backup so you can get even further away!

Continue to Mission 8!

Polar bears might look cute but you should keep your distance. They can be aggressive and have been known to attack humans. Getting in the cold water won't help – they're speedy swimmers! Start over!

**EXTRA CHALLENGE**

Explorer Mike Libeck puts a fun animal mask on every time he finishes an expedition. Use pens, card and string to make your own mask. Ask an adult to cut eye holes for you.

## MISSION 8 DESIGN A VEHICLE

Your team has arrived on special vehicles, ready to race you away from the polar bear. Build one of these cool rides, or create your own, inspired by them! Remember, it needs to be able to cross melting sea ice.

ICE RIDER SWOOSH ACROSS SEA ICE USING PROPELLER POWER!

SNOWMOBILE SPEED OVER SNOW ON FOUR SKIS!

Wet a pair of socks then put them in the freezer. After a few hours try to put them on!
