Top teepee!

What you'll need

- Strong rubber bands
- Bamboo canes
- Fabric paints
- Paint brushes
- Double bed sheet
- String
- Scissors
- Old newspaper
- Sticky tape
- Pencil
- Ribbon
- Feathers

DID YOU KNOW...?

Teepees were originally used by Native American Indians as shelters that could easily be moved if the tribe needed to relocate. Cool!

Start here!

1 First, lay the bed sheet over some old newspaper and secure the edges with sticky tape.

2 Next, design the pattern for your teepee using a pencil, and then colour it in using the fabric paints.

3 Now, hold the bamboo sticks together and wrap a rubber band around the top of them, making sure it's GOOD and tight!

4 Spread the bamboo posts apart at the bottom, leaving a bigger gap for the door. Now drape the fabric over the sticks.

5 Finally, secure the top of the fabric with string and decorate with ribbons and feathers. Now you're ready to explore your new adventure base!
