



# PAPER SPIRALS

These eye-boggling decorations look complex but are a doddle to make!

## What you'll need




- Squares of paper (We used doubled sided origami paper but plain paper is fine)
- Scissors • Ruler • Sticky tape

## Start here!


1

Fold your square into a triangle. Then fold into a triangle again.





With the long unfolded edge at the bottom, and the single fold to your right, draw a line about 1.5cm from the thickest edge on the left side.

Now measure 1.5-cm-wide stripes from the folded edge to the line, and cut along them.



## TOP TIP

When Christmas is over, carefully take your decorations down and save them for next year!



Carefully unfold out into a square again. Loop the two inside triangles around your finger so the points overlap, then join them with a bit of tape.

Flip the paper over and stick the next two triangles together so the points overlap (left). Flip and repeat until all the triangles have been fastened.

Finally, make a hole at the top and thread some ribbon through so you can hang up your decoration!


