




6 of 6: FLOWER




Fold your square of paper in half diagonally then unfold and fold diagonally the other way. Unfold again.




Turn the paper over. Fold the paper in half both ways and then unfold.




Turn the paper so that it's diagonal. Fold the left and right corners inwards down to the bottom, while bringing the top point down to the bottom. This will form a square.




Make sure the open end of the model is at the top, then fold the top-right layer in to the centre, so that the lower-right edge meets the central crease. Do the same on the left side.




Unfold the last two folds. Turn the right flap towards the left, at the same time lifting and opening it out, then flattening it, so that what was the right edge is now the crease down the centre.




Turn the top layer on the right to the left. Fold the right flap in to the centre crease and then open and flatten as in step 5.




Turn the model over. Fold the top-right layer in to the crease and then open and flatten as in step 5. Repeat step 6.



Fold the top-left and right layers in to the centre. Turn the top-right layer to the left and fold the next right-hand flap in. Repeat.



Turn the model over and repeat step 8.



Turn the top-right layer to the left. Fold the flap at the top down, then turn the next two layers on the right to the left, and fold the flap at the top down.



Turn the model over. Fold the flap at the top down, then turn the next two layers on the right to the left, and fold the flap at the top down.



Open out the model and petals to form your flower!
