What needs to change?





How Siena is helping!



What needs to change?

While studying electronics in a village called Pabal, India, Hemang noticed that there weren't many trees in the city. Hot temperatures and frequent droughts made it hard for plants to grow there, and local people often struggled to get enough water, too. These issues got Hemang thinking about climate change, and he was determined to make a difference! The youngster decided to help raise environmental awareness, and from there, his ideas grew and grew!

Hemang loves science and technology – now he's combining this knowledge to help our planet!

How Hemang is helping!

Hemang is organising awareness campaigns and workshops in schools in Hyderabad, India, to teach other kids all about climate change. So far, he's planned six different kinds of activities - including painting and drawing workshops using recycled materials, plastic waste up-cycle sessions, and eco-housing projects using environmentally-friendly bricks!

The young environmentalist plans to run online workshops, too, and he'll be helping the natural world blossom by planting ten trees every month. *Tree-mendous* work, Hemang!

Trees help prevent climate change by absorbing carbon dioxide (a gas that contributes towards global warming) and releasing precious oxygen!

When Rhenan's family moved to a city named Araguatins, Brazil, he noticed that the local Araguaia River, and the streams that fed into it, were heavily polluted with all kinds of rubbish. But the river hadn't always been like that...

The Araguaia River had once been a place of natural beauty that both people and wildlife could enjoy. What's more, it provided thousands of local families with clean water for cooking and washing. So, compelled to act, Rhenan decided to make a change!

How Rhenan is helping!



And his mission doesn't stop there - the young water warrior is talking to local governments and organisations about how Brazil's waterways can have a pollution-free future. Go, Rhenan!





What needs to change?

Ivanna lives near the Madín dam, a huge reservoir near Mexico City. As well as providing fresh water for the local people, the reservoir once supported a thriving ecosystem of birds, fish and other amazing animals!

Sadly, in 2019, construction companies began to dump sewage and waste into the reservoir, making it unsafe for people. Wildlife also suffered, as water lilies infested the water's surface and took over, damaging the entire ecosystem! Many fish died as a result, and the local bird species disappeared. Ivanna knew something had to be done, so she decided to take action...

Ivanna's latest petition, to stop sewage being dumped in the dam, already has over **70,000** signatures, and counting!

How Ivanna is helping!

Ivanna started a petition calling for authorities and CONAGUA - the company that monitors water in the area - to clean up the Madín dam. And with a whopping 19,000 signatures, they had to take notice!

Money was allocated to remove the lilies, and workers were sent to clean-up the water. Ivanna and her community got stuck in too, and today, the reservoir is lily-free! Ivanna's next mission is to put an end to sewage dumping so that wildlife may return to the area. What amazing work!

KidsRights is an awesome charity that finds, funds and supports young people that want to make a difference in the world! It's the organisation behind the International Children's Peace Prize - awarded each year to amazing kids that stand up for the rights of other kids around the world. Cool!
